- Experience with towing vessel operations.
- Experience with towing vessel repairs, including conducting repairs in accordance with NVIC 7-68.
- Experience utilizing Microsoft Office 365, with the ability to create Word documents, Excel spreadsheets, and PowerPoint presentations.
- Possess the necessary skills to create process documents within an ISO 9001:2015 framework and collaborate on the development of training and TPO program materials.
- Flexibility to travel occasionally to attend business meetings or to participate in TVIB training sessions.
- Experience conducting management and towing vessel audits, for compliance with the AWO RCP Program, ISM Code, and/or subchapter M regulations, or equivalent programs.
- Experience conducting internal audits of a Quality Management System, or other audited management systems, to ensure compliance with the organization's ISO 9001:2015 certification.
- Experience conducting training in a traditional classroom setting, webinars, and industry meetings.
- Experience conducting surveys:
 - o Subchapter M topside towing vessel annual surveys,
 - Subchapter M dry dock surveys,
 - Conducting internal structural exams of towing vessels or similar vessels.
- Individuals that have achieved TVIB status as Certified Lead auditors, and/or TVIB certified Dry Dock/ ISE certified, or equivalent levels of certification are preferred.
 - For those without previous TVIB certification, the successful applicant will be required to achieve these certifications as soon as possible following employment with TVIB.
 - TVIB will provide training at TVIB's expense to achieve these certifications.
- Ability to provide oversight and training of both third party and internal auditors and surveyors by reviewing audit and survey reports for accuracy, consistency, and proper reporting findings in an objective and correct manner, as outlined in the TVIB quality management system.
